### MISSING LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH INMATE IS CAPTURED AND RETURNED TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough inmate DeJohn Williams was returned to OCCC at 4 p.m. by the Honolulu Police. He failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center after work Friday evening. Williams left Friday morning and was scheduled to return by 6:30 p.m.

Williams was serving time for promoting a dangerous drug. His next parole hearing was scheduled for December.

Williams is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
