To establish guidelines for inmate solicitations and contributions.

Contributions - monies received from approved sources, which are deposited into individual inmate accounts.

3.0 POLICY


- .1 Solicitation of monies from inmates by any type of organization shall not be permitted. Facilities shall not approve, solicit or become involved in the collection of monies from inmates for any organization.
- .2 Only persons listed on the inmate's approved correspondence and visiting card may contribute money to the inmate.
- .3 All authorized contributions shall be deposited into the inmate's account.


