## HALAWA INMATE FACES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AFTER ATTACKING A CORRECTIONS OFFICER

HONOLULU – At approximately 9 a.m., an inmate housed in the special needs facility at Halawa Correctional Facility attacked a sergeant who was doing routine cell inspections. Inmate Daniel Walker was restrained immediately and the situation was brought under control in less than a minute.

The sergeant sustained minor injuries and went to the hospital on his own to be checked out.

32-year-old Walker, faces disciplinary action. He is serving time for Theft 2.
