### **MISSING WCCC INMATES FAIL TO RETURN FROM FURLOUGH DAY PASSES**

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Cheryl Nihoa failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass on April 7. She was scheduled to return at 6:15 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Nihoa was serving time for Assault and drug-related charges. Escape 2 is expected to be added. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for September of this year.

Nihoa is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. She is 32-years old. She is 5'3" tall, weighs 142 lbs. and has brown hair and brown eyes.

Furlough inmate Jorelyn Pacariem failed to return to the facility from her furlough day pass on March 19. She left in the morning and was scheduled to return by 2:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Pacariem was serving time for drug-related charges as well as forgery and I.D. theft. Escape 2 is expected to be added as a new charge. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for July of this year.

Pacariem is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level. She is 37-years old. She is 5'2", weighs 140 lbs. and has brown hair and brown eyes.
