OCCC FURLOUGH PROGRAM INMATE CAPTURED BY STATE SHERIFFS

HONOLULU – State Sheriffs, acting on an anonymous tip, captured work furlough walkaway Dorian Guerpo at 4 p.m. on Waiwai Loop near the Honolulu International Airport.

Dorian Guerpo failed to return from a furlough pass to the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Module 20 on Monday, October 12. Guerpo left on a job-seeking pass and was scheduled to return by 5 p.m.

Guerpo was serving time for Robbery 1. Escape 2 is expected to be added to his charges. His next parole hearing was scheduled for March 2016.

38-year old Guerpo is classified as community custody which is the lowest custody level.
