## PAROLE VIOLATOR TURNS HIMSELF IN TO SHERIFFS

HONOLULU – Parolee Bronson Gouveia turned himself in to Sheriffs at about 12:30 p.m. in the Honolulu area. Sheriffs are currently processing him for a parole violation. Gouveia will be taken to the Oahu Community Correctional Center for intake processing and then transported to the Halawa Correctional Facility.

The Hawaii Paroling Authority (HPA) issued a warrant Thursday morning for Gouveia after he ran from his parole officer during a routine check-in. Deputies, who arrived at the building as Gouveia was fleeing, ordered him to stop but he got into a waiting car that sped off.

Gouveia's record includes attempted assault 1, burglary 1, robbery 1, weapons possession and drug charges. He now faces revocation of parole.
