MISSING WCCC EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE RETURNED TO WCCC

HONOLULU – Missing extended furlough inmate Alpha Iuli (pronounced E-uli) was returned to the Women's Community Correctional Center this evening. Honolulu Police arrested Iuli over the weekend. Iuli's was on an extended furlough pass and failed to check in at the facility on February 28.

Iuli (49 yrs. old) is serving time for Theft 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to her charges. She was tentatively approved for parole and awaiting the parole board to set the release date.

She is a community custody inmate on extended furlough with pass privileges. Community Custody is the lowest custody level. Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the facility but must check in at various times throughout the month.
