**OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY**

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Lyle Botelho failed to return to OCCC Module 20 work furlough housing last night. He left for work in the morning and was supposed to return by 8:30 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

38-year old Botelho is 6'0" tall and weighs 276 lbs. He has black and grey hair and brown eyes. He also has a tattoo on his neck that says "Sabrina".

Botelho is serving time for Methamphetamine Trafficking 2. His next parole hearing was scheduled for January. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
