**WOMEN'S COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER FURLOUGH INMATE  
ASHLEY AKANA FAILED TO RETURN**

Work furlough inmate Ashley Akana failed to return to WCCC furlough housing unit tonight. She was supposed to return by 9:30 pm. Sheriffs and HPD were notified.

Akana is 34 years old, 5'4" tall, and 210 lbs. She has brown hair and brown eyes.

Akana is serving time for Burglary 1<sup>st</sup>, multiple Theft offenses, Forgery of Credit Cards, Promoting Dangerous Drugs 3<sup>rd</sup>. Her minimum sentence will expire on 11/2/2019. She now faces an additional escape charge when found.

She is a community custody inmate in the furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
