

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 5/3/21

1 KCCC Employee Positive, Mass Testing Underway

One (1) Kauai Community Correctional Center (KCCC) employee reported a positive test result to the facility. The employee last worked Thursday, April 29. No KCCC inmates have reported symptoms but as a precaution the facility has enacted their pandemic protocol to quarantine the facility and suspend all inmate movement. The facility health care staff and the Department of Health have initiated contact tracing and voluntary testing for all inmates and staff. The facility sanitized the spaces where the employee worked.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. There are currently no active COVID-19 cases in the inmate population. The Maui Community Correctional Center reports 76 test results. Of that number 75 were negative and one (1) is considered a non-active post-positive. PSD Health Care Division staff consulted with DOH and it was determined that the inmate is shedding old virus and is not contagious. The inmate will be added to the recovered list. There were also 21 negative staff test results reported for MCCC. The Oahu Community Correctional Center reports 29 negative inmate test results and the Women's Community Correctional Center reports four (4) negative inmate results.
