### **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE**

HONOLULU – The Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) reports two new positive staff test results received bringing the total staff positives to 11. No new inmate test results were received today.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The inmate test results received at other facilities are as follows:

Oahu Community Correctional Center – 24 negative inmate test results

Maui Community Correctional Center – 12 negative inmate test results

Waiawa Correctional Facility – 2 negative inmate test result

Women's Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results

Halawa Correctional Facility – 1 negative inmate test result

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
